The NICE recommends that people living with diabetes have the following 9 annual checks:

- 1 Body mass index (BMI)
- 2 Urinary albumin test
- 3 Blood pressure
- 4 Serum creatinine test
- 5 Smoking status
- 6 Cholesterol levels
- 7 HbA1c measurement
- 8 Foot check
- 9 Eye check (retinopathy screening)*

With the right training and clinical supervision, unregistered healthcare staff can be supported to efficiently deliver 8 of these diabetes care processes.

**Retinal screening needs to be done by appropriately trained staff with suitable retinal photography equipment.*
