e-Portfolio (supported) Route Update

The Centre for Advancing Practice ePortfolio (supported) Route is designed to enable Practitioners to evidence that they meet the advanced practice capabilities described in the [Multi-professional framework for advanced clinical practice in England](#) (MPF).

Currently, one-way practitioners would evidence this would be by successfully completing a Centre accredited Advanced Practice Programme. The ePortfolio (supported) Route will provide an alternative route to do this by mapping knowledge and skills to the MPF using the Centre's ePortfolio. It therefore provides an alternative route for experienced practitioners to gain advanced practice recognition equivalence. The rationale for this process is that practitioners may not have had the opportunity to complete an accredited MSc ACP programme for example their MSc may have been undertaken before the publication of the [Multi-professional framework for advanced clinical practice in England](#) (MPF).
