What we do

R&D office function for primary and community care

Together with our sister office at NHS Norfolk and Waveney ICB, we provide R&D support for research in out-of-hospital settings across the NIHR Regional Research Delivery Network (RRDN) for the East of England: **primary care; community care; population health; and wider health and care (non-NHS) settings** – care homes, schools, prisons *etc.*

Supporting research capability in primary care and wider settings

We also host national NIHR research grants and work with system partners to grow local research capability for primary care and wider settings, including via clinical-academic, research support and inclusion posts and initiatives



NIHR grant application development funding

- **Research Capability Funding (RCF) awards of up to £10,000**
- Funds staff time to develop new NIHR grant applications for primary care or wider community settings to be hosted by CPICB
- Suitable for academic / primary care researchers – NOT for NHS Trust employees
- For work up to end of March 2026
- For NIHR applications up to end of July 2026
- Current round open until **2 October**
- **Eligibility expanded to include BLMK & HWE** for the first time
